Crowning Glory!

Weave bendy willow or hazel sticks into a circle and decorate your crown with leaves and grasses

TRAIL 1

Lay a trail for others to find you using arrows made of sticks

Take a perch

Watch the world go by from a safe seat in the boughs of a tree

4



TRAIL 2

Mark your territory like the animals and lay a scented trail (e.g. with garlic or lemon rubbed on trees)

5



FOX HOLE

Make a hidden den to spy from by laying sticks and leaves over a dip in the ground

6



Trail 3

Tie rope or string between trees and use it to explore the woodland blindfolded

7



TREE PEOPLE

Bring trees to life with faces made of mud or clay

'Tree top walk'

Walk on air - place an upward-facing hand mirror on the end of your nose and carefully wander around the woods



Boat Race

Make natural mini rafts from bark and leaves and race them down stream

SWING HIGH

Throw a rope over a sturdy branch then tie to either end of a strong stick seat

Leaf it

Arrange leaves by colour and shape to create repeating patterns

FACE-OFF

Make natural face-paints from blackberries, clay and mud!

FAIRY DENS

Make a home for the woodland folk in the roots of a tree

Journey sticks

Tell the story of your walk by tying found objects like feathers, favourite leaves and seeds to your walking stick

WHO'S IN THE WOODS?

Spot signs of wildlife like footprints, nibbled pine cones or even animal poo!

16



Be still

Sit quietly under a favourite tree and listen to bird song
